When we first published our newsletter, our dear friend, Mary Gonzales, volunteered to proofread it. She was such a blessing and faithfully continued doing this until a bad case of Covid made it impossible for her to continue. Rather than send out an appeal for someone to replace her, we decided to try an online service called Grammarly. Grammarly does a good job, but it has a problem: It does not understand spiritual concepts.

Recently, I sent someone a letter and wrote, "Every day, we pray that God will make us a blessing." Even though that sentence is straightforward and easy to understand, Grammarly had a problem with it. It insisted that the sentence read, "Every day, we pray that God will bless us." No matter how I tried to rewrite it, Grammarly couldn't accept that anyone would want to be a blessing!

This got me thinking: Why am I here? Did God have a divine plan for my life, and if so, what was it? Many people struggle with these questions, and as a result, they often feel empty and frustrated.

A while back, I read an article about Johnny Manziel, the famous football player who the Cleveland Browns chose as the number one draft pick in 2014. I had money. I had fame. ... And, for some reason, when I got there and got everything I wanted, I think that was truly the most empty I had ever felt inside."

Johnny Manziel is not alone. Many have pursued their dreams and achieved what they set out to accomplish, only to find that it brought them no happiness or fulfillment. Others spend a lifetime feeling like failures because they cannot obtain their goals. If you relate to either of these scenarios, I want you to know that there is an answer. When we retired, we had to revisit that question. Pouring our lives into Rez had brought us such fulfillment, but overnight, our lives had changed. Now, what did God want us to do? As we searched for an answer, we stumbled upon a great truth: **God's plan for our lives had not changed. His plan was never for us to build a large church; His plan was for us to bless as many people as possible.**

The church became large because, first and foremost, everything we did was done in an effort to bless people. Every thought and every action came forth out of this matrix. That is why we started RCS, Praise In The Park, and Fall Fest. The list goes on and on. We soon learned that the more we blessed people, the more people we had to bless. We had found the perfect formula for church growth.

When this happens, God's blessing is lifted, and they are doomed to failure. At Rez, we never experienced this because our first desire was to be a blessing to our community and those who chose to make Rez their church home.

In the workplace, try to be a blessing to your boss and your co-workers. In your neighborhood, try to be a blessing to your neighbors. In your church, try to be a blessing to your pastor. When you go to a restaurant, bless the person serving you by leaving a generous tip. You will soon see God using you in amazing ways. I must warn you: Grammarly will not understand you, but be assured, God will, and it will put a smile on His face. You will have found God's perfect plan for your life.

Repentance is necessary when we come to Christ; this is Salvation 101. If there is no need to repent, then we have no need of a savior, and the entire message of the cross becomes foolishness.

But we all know that is not how it works. Before we come to Christ, we are slaves to sin, and our thoughts and actions reveal how undone we are. This knowledge causes us to come to Christ, confess our sins, cast ourselves upon the mercy of God, repent, and turn from our wickedness. To reject this message is to remain in our lost, deplorable condition with no hope of salvation.

This is the basic message of salvation, but there is something else we need to consider. After coming to Jesus, what part should repentance continue to play in the believer's life? Few have considered this question, and as a result, they may be in great danger. To help you understand this, I want to start by looking at the world we live in.

We are living at a time when sin and rebellion against God and His Word have become more rampant than ever, maybe even worse than what was happening before the great flood of Noah's time

and the destruction of Sodom and Gomorrah in Lot's time. Finding movies without vulgar language and immoral scenes has become almost impossible. Almost daily, we are told to accept sins as normal human behavior that God says are an abomination to Him. Because this is the environment we live in, we need to ask ourselves, what effect this is having on us? Are we becoming desensitized to the wickedness we live in? Let's take a look at that question.

The Bible teaches that we have all been given a conscience that helps us discern right from wrong. Every human has a conscience regardless of their spiritual or cultural condition. However, the Bible also teaches that sin can weaken or corrupt our conscience.

Titus 1:15 KJV

15...but even their mind and conscience is defiled.

1 Timothy 4:1-2 KJV

1 Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils;

2 Speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron;

These warnings suddenly become very relevant because they are specifically directed to those who will be living in "the latter times."

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Billy Graham said this about our conscience:

"Tragically, however, our conscience—this inner moral compass that ought to point us to right and wrong—can become dulled and suppressed, and we may not even be able to hear its warnings. Instead, we deliberately choose to do wrong—and the more we do this, the more calloused or hardened our conscience becomes."

This is very serious because it places us in great danger.

1 Timothy 1:19 KJV

19 Holding faith, and a good conscience; which some having put away concerning faith have made shipwreck:

When I look at the church today, I cannot help but wonder if this verse describes our spiritual condition and where we are headed. Has our conscience become hardened? Far too often, the church looks very similar to the world. Not only do we look like the world, but we

talk like the world. We embrace entertainers of the world even though they live ungodly lives and promote ungodly causes. In an effort to reach the world, many accept the sin of the world. How can we not see that we are headed for shipwreck?

I believe we are, and I submit our nation as proof. The United States of America is no longer "united." Abraham Lincoln said, "A house divided against itself cannot stand." That was a quote taken directly from the Bible, and you can be sure it will come to pass.

Our country is at war with itself and the outcome of that war is becoming very clear.

Without God's intervention, the nation we love will soon cease to exist. We are quickly reaching the point of no return, yet church leaders sound no cry of alarm. Why? God's Word declares that judgment must begin in the house of the Lord, which means the church must repent.

2 Chronicles 7:14 King James Version

14 If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

It is not too late, nor impossible for God to turn this around, but if that is to happen, God's people must repent. It is time for the church to wake up and be the church described in the Bible.
