

Victory! There is not one person on the planet who doesn't love a victory, and it doesn't matter whether it is a sporting event or an ascent to the summit of a high mountain peak. When we experience victory, the emotion we feel on the inside cannot be contained, and we unashamedly shout for joy. We have just conquered! We have overcome! There is nothing in the world like it.

This year, at the Winter Olympics, both the men's and women's hockey teams won gold medals. The entire nation celebrated, and the men's team was invited to be recognized by President Trump at his State of the Union address. Even some of the Democrats applauded these sports heroes!

But when discussing victory, we should not limit ourselves to sporting events. How about the victory someone experiences when they have been declared cancer-free? I know how that feels because recently I experienced it myself. Last year, I was diagnosed with a very aggressive form of bladder cancer. Subsequently, I received six weeks of treatment, and then on January 23 of this year, I had my bladder scoped and was declared cancer-free. The cancer was completely gone. Victory! I love victory, and for me, that was a victory even greater than winning a gold medal.

In the Bible, we find many illustrations of amazing victories. One of my favorites is the story of David and Goliath. What were the chances of victory? David didn't stand a chance. He was going to die. That is why when Goliath lay dead on the ground, with his head severed from his body, the armies of Israel erupted with shouts of joy. What a great moment that must have been! But that is not the greatest victory found in the Bible.

Without doubt, there is one that stands far above any other, and that is the moment Jesus came out of the tomb, victorious over death, hell, and the grave. All power and authority had been given to him. You talk about snatching victory out of

the jaws of defeat; this was the ultimate example of that. A man hanging lifeless on a cross is the ultimate picture of defeat. But he was only defeated until he wasn't, and he wasn't when he came out of the tomb, victorious!

But now we must talk about a huge problem. The problem is that we all want victory, but we don't want any battles. As much as we love victories, we hate battles even more! If we had our way, we would never have to fight a battle. There would be no mountains to climb, no giants to kill, no crosses to carry, and no cancers to overcome. The only hockey we might play would be practice scrimmages against an invisible opponent. There would also be one other thing missing in our lives; there would be no victories because, before you can have a victory, you must have a battle. Please, let that truth sink deep into your soul.

The only way to answer that question is to look into God's word and see what he has to say about what the days will be like before he returns. That is what I am going to do now. Without adding any commentary, we will let God's word speak for itself. Here is what the Bible tells us the world will look like just before Jesus returns.

1. Moral decay

Matthew 24:12 King James Version
12 And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.

2. Military Conflicts

Matthew 24:6 King James Version
6 And ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars: see that ye be not troubled: for all these things must come to pass...

3. Natural Disasters

Luke 21:11 King James Version
11 And great earthquakes shall be in divers places, and famines, and pestilences...

4. Rise of False Prophets

Matthew 24:11 King James Version
11 And many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many.

5. Rebirth of Israel

Amos 9:14-15 King James Version
14 And I will bring again the captivity of my people of Israel, and they shall build the waste cities, and inhabit them; and they shall plant vineyards, and drink the wine thereof; they shall also make gardens, and eat the fruit of them.

15 And I will plant them upon their land, and they shall no more be pulled up out of their land which I have given them, saith the LORD thy God.

6. Persecution of Believers

Matthew 24:9 King James Version

9 Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and ye shall be hated of all nations for my name's sake.

7. Signs in the Heavens

Luke 21:25 King James Version

25 And there shall be signs in the sun, and in the moon, and in the stars...

8. Knowledge and Travel Shall Increase

Daniel 12:4 King James Version

4 But thou, O Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book, even to the time of the end: many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased.

9. Worldwide Preaching of the Gospel

Matthew 24:14 King James Version

14 And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.

10. Scoffers

2 Peter 3:3 King James Version

3 Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts...

I will let you be the judge. Does that list describe the world we are living in today? I am very sure that all except those who purpose in their heart to be blind would say that it does.

There is one other spiritual similarity to the month of March that I have not yet mentioned, and that is the blowing of the wind.


Joel 2:28 Amplified Bible

28 "It shall come about after this that I shall pour out My Spirit on all mankind; And your sons and your daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions.

"Iran Explained"

Last month, I showed you how the overthrow of the Iranian government could lead to the peace and safety Israel will be living in when Ezekiel 38 is fulfilled. While this is a very real possibility, it raises a question that demands an answer.

But first, we must look at what a post-Islamic Iran might look like. Many people do not know this, but in present-day Iran, Christianity is growing faster than anywhere else in the world. This, in spite of the fact that in Iran, converting from Islam to Christianity is a crime punishable by death. One can only imagine what might happen should the radical Islamic regime fall. A revival of unprecedented proportions could follow!

This possibility brings us to our question. In Ezekiel 38, Iran is listed as the first nation that will join Russia in attacking Israel. If Islam no longer rules Iran, and Christianity has gained great influence in the country, how is it possible that Iran would attack Israel in the future?

This is a fair question that has a very simple answer. We must remember that just because the Islamic regime in Iran falls, it does not mean that Islam will have fallen. Islam is a horrible evil cancer that has plagued humanity since its inception, and Ezekiel 38 reveals that it will still be a very real threat in the future.

So, let's explore a storyline where all of the above happens, and yet at some point in the future, Islam again seizes power in Iran and attacks Israel. How could this possibly happen? There is only one scenario in which this could happen, and that involves the rapture. Think about it, the Islamic regime falls, Iran experiences a great revival with millions converting to Christianity, then the rapture happens, and instantly all those Iranian Christians disappear. Without doubt, Islam would then be able to once again take control because Muslims are not going up in the rapture!

In this storyline, Islam would have seven years to reclaim control of Iran, rebuild its military might, and again become a threat to Israel. It all seems to fit, but is it just a storyline, or are there any scriptures that might confirm it? Let's take a look.

The key to finding an answer is to look at how the invasion of Israel in Ezekiel 38 ends.

Ezekiel 38:18;20; KJV

18 And it shall come to pass at the same time when Gog shall come against the land of Israel, saith the Lord GOD, that my fury shall come up in my face.

20...and all the men that are upon the face of the earth, **shall shake at my presence....**

This should be taken literally. It tells us that when Jesus comes to Israel's rescue, the whole world will tremble at his presence. Zachariah 14 also speaks of this.

Zechariah 14:3-4

3 Then shall the LORD go forth, and fight against those nations, as when he fought in the day of battle.

4 On that day his feet will stand on the Mount of Olives, which faces Jerusalem on the east....

I will be the first to admit that this is not a deep exegetical study of scripture. It is a storyline created and supported by hand-picking scriptures that could be applied to it. Will it happen exactly as I have presented it to you? I do not know. All I can tell you for sure is that God is involved with what is happening in Iran, and that makes it exciting and wonderful.

Once again, we are reminded that we are living in the generation when all things prophesied in God's word will be fulfilled. We are the generation that will see the return of Jesus!
