FEATURE ARTICLE: "Does God Have Favorites?"

WARNING: You are entering the "TRUTH ZONE". You may not like what you read. At times it may make you feel uncomfortable. That is not my goal. My goal is to speak truth that will provide spiritual guidance for you and your family in a time of great spiritual darkness.

You can be sure that what you read here will be TRUTH!

I don't know if you're like me, but it seems some people get more miracles than others. Every time you see them they are talking about the most recent thing God has just done and are so vocal about it that you find yourself getting a bit uncomfortable. I can't blame them, because there is nothing more exciting than **seeing** God extend His hand and work a miracle right before your eyes. Miss Linda and I have had it happen many times and like others, we love to talk about it.

This leads me to the question I want to deal with: Does God have favorites? Why do some always see miracles while others never see them? This is a question I am sure many have pondered. It is tempting to throw a blanket over a difficult question like this and call it covered, but we must remember that doing this can be very damaging. A good illustration would be the standard answer some give which is: "Some just don't have enough faith." This is often followed by, "Without faith, it is impossible to please God."

There it is, question answered! But is it?

Satan's main objective is to make us feel separated from God, and one of his favorite tactics

is to bring God's people under condemnation. When we make a blanket statement such as this we give him all the ammunition he needs to get the job done. Soon we begin feeling like God is withholding His blessing because, in His eyes, we are underperforming. This results in a terrible situation, making it impossible for our faith to grow. All our good intentions and efforts have only served to exacerbate the problem.

With this in mind, I would like to give you an alternative that I believe can be life-changing. It is found in Proverbs.

Proverbs 3:6 KJV

6 In all thy ways acknowledge him.....

Earlier in this article, I asked, "Why do some always see miracles while others never see them?" Proverbs 3 tells us to see God in everything. Can it be that the problem is not that God isn't working miracles, but rather that some fail to see what God is doing? I suggest this may be a bigger problem than we realize. Some may counter by arguing that a true miracle is impossible not to see. Really? Perhaps it is easier to charge God with favoritism than to accept that we are not acknowledging the hand of God in the small things we experience every day.

Let me give you some examples. When is the last time you acknowledged God and gave Him glory for the beautiful sunrise or sunset you were privileged to see? Or how about that amazing encounter you had with a beautiful bird? Miss Linda and I call these kind of things "A kiss from God." In our world, there is no such thing as a coincidence.

We acknowledge God in everything!

I promise, this is a great way to live and if you embrace it you will never lack for miracles.







"Our God Reigns!"

It is normal for us humans to want to be in total control of our lives, but where does God fit into that? This is a question most of us wrestle with and as a result, when difficult times come we often are left

shaken and confused. Our faith feels more like a thin thread that we cling to than a solid rock on which we stand.

Most of us recognize that God needs to have at least some place in our lives, but unfortunately, our theology often places Him in a position of subordination to us. With great joy, we lift our hands and sing, "Our God reigns" but at the same time believe that He must do whatever we ask. Inevitably this will lead to problems because sooner or later God will do something that does not fit your theology and when He does He will not ask your permission. This is an absolute that will never change.

Psalm 135:6 AMP

6 Whatever the Lord pleases, He does...

Psalm 115:3 King James Version

3 But our God is in the heavens: he hath done whatsoever he hath pleased.

Isaiah 41:4 ERV

4 Who was able to make all this happen? Who controlled the lives of everyone from the beginning? I, the Lord, am the one. I was here at the beginning, and I will be here when all things are finished.

In spite of what these verses say, many embrace a belief system that takes away the sovereignty of Almighty God and puts them in charge. As a result, they find themselves asking, "Where is God? Why doesn't He fix this?" Some tell us it is because we lack faith while others come up with a ridiculously simple explanation that only creates more questions. They say, "When bad things happen just remember that all good things come from God and all bad things come from the devil." Now that explains everything! But, isn't God more powerful than the devil and if so, why doesn't He intervene? We cannot comprehend that God would do something different than what we want.

In the book of Isaiah God says something about himself that answers a lot of questions.

Isaiah 45:7 King James Version

7 I form the light, and create darkness: I make peace, and create evil: I the Lord do all these things.

How can He be good if He creates evil? The word "evil" used in this verse means adversity, affliction, calamity, distress, hurt, sorrow, trouble, and ill. Why would a good God create these things?

The more I study my Bible, the more I am convinced that the God I serve is sovereign, supreme, and the everlasting ruler of the universe.


I can trust Him!
