PROPHECY UPDATE

"Something To Think About"

Most would agree that we are living in the season of our Lord's return. We also know that other specific prophecies must yet be fulfilled before He returns. In this article, I hope to make you aware of just how close we may be to the return of our Lord by looking at one of those prophecies. The prophecy I am referring to is found in Daniel 9.

Daniel 9:27 KJV

27 And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.

This verse isn't a symbolic statement or a vague metaphor. It is a specific prophecy about a specific event: the antichrist confirming a covenant with many for one week, or seven years. This covenant will look like peace. It will sound like peace. It will be celebrated globally as peace. However, it will be a deception, a trap that ushers in the most terrifying era in human history—the Great Tribulation. (Daniel 12:1) Is it possible that this event could be very near? Let's take a look.

In May of this year, President Donald Trump announced that he was very close to making a deal with several Arab nations. He called it the "Deal of the Millennium." It turned out to be mostly about trade agreements, rather than peace treaties. But let's assume it had been about a 7-year peace deal that was designed to finally bring peace between Jews and Arabs, with Donald Trump guaranteeing the safety and security of Israel. What would you be thinking right now?

I would be thinking that what I have taught in the past was incorrect and that we have just witnessed the fulfillment of Daniel 9:27, indicating that Donald Trump is the antichrist. Now, please don't freak out and write me nasty letters. A seven-year treaty has not been announced, and I did not call Trump the antichrist. I merely used the events that occurred in May to illustrate how easily something like this could happen.

The technological, political, and religious landscape is aligning in ways that would have seemed impossible just a few decades ago. Global institutions are already calling for peace in the Middle East. The stage is being set, and the shadows of these events are already visible. And what does all this mean for us today?

Now is the time to wake up, Church! Now is the time to make sure your lamp is burning brightly, your heart is ready, and your eyes are fixed on the eastern sky. The signs are converging. The prophecies are aligning. And our redemption is drawing near!

And if you are a believer, this is not the time for fear—it is the time for faith. Faith should be easy because we are living in a time when prophecy is being fulfilled right before our eyes. Let us live with urgency, share the Gospel with boldness, and encourage one another all the more as we see the Day approaching (Hebrews 10:25).

Also, we must not forget that we will not be here when the antichrist confirms this covenant. Scripture teaches that the rapture of the Church—the sudden, catching away of believers—must occur **before** the tribulation begins (1 Thessalonians 4:16–17; Revelation 3:10). We shouldn't be looking for the antichrist, but we should be looking for Jesus Christ.
