If you could ask God for anything, what would it be? In 1 Kings 3, Solomon was given just such an opportunity. He was told to ask God for **anything** he desired and instead of asking for riches, he asked for a heart of understanding so he could be a blessing to those under his rule. We see God's response in verses 10-12.

1 Kings 3:10-12 NIV

10 The Lord was pleased that Solomon had asked for this.

11 So God said to him, "Since you have asked for this and not for long life or wealth for yourself, nor have asked for the death of your enemies but for discernment in administering justice,

12 I will do what you have asked. I will give you a wise and discerning heart, so that there will never have been anyone like you, nor will there ever be.

I have thought a lot about this and feel that contained in it is a spiritual truth that will be a great blessing to the Body of Christ. Let me start by setting up a scenario that I believe describes how many people feel. As you continue reading, see whether or not I might be telling your story. You attend a church where week after week you hear testimonies of the amazing things God has done for others, but secretly it bothers you because you have not seen that kind of thing happen in your life. You ask yourself, "Why do others experience miracles, but I go year after year and see nothing?" If you feel

8 and then that same nation I warned turns away from its evil, then I will change My plans. In My compassion, I will not destroy it.


